

Artist Statement

"The use of beads is a central element of my work. I carefully suspend each bead individually with fishline strings, hung from a steel rod, to create a cohesive image. The meticulous and labour-intensive nature of my art medium is a tribute to the strength of the African continent. Each bead represents an individual, but when brought together, they create a community. The large-scale picture made of thousands of small beads is a testament to the power of many small parts converging to form something greater and whole. It is a reminder that every individual is essential and has the potential to contribute to the collective strength of a community. Through the use of different shades of green and red, I aim to create a contrast between the coolness of human figures and the warmth of the natural environment. My approach to colour is that each colour represents a collective aspect of the African experience. Themes in my work are diversity and the uniqueness of African identity. My ultimate goal is to convey a message of celebrating diversity and coming together. The African community is an excellent example of this, and through my art, I aim to honour and commemorate their beauty and resilience. By highlighting the power of community, I hope to inspire others to create and embrace a world where everyone feels seen, heard, and valued."
