

Artist Statement

"The act of making, whatever form it has taken, has always given me a sense of self and identity. When asked what I do, I have always responded with "I am a maker, I make things". It has been a thread that has run throughout my life and it is through my making that I discover who and what and why I am in this world. It is a means to 'nosce te ipsum', a means to 'know thyself'. My artwork is process driven - it is the 'making' that most times is more important than the finished work. For me, making becomes an end in itself. I like getting my hands dirty. The process of creating, and the interaction with materials, tools, and different techniques and applications are all integral to, and equally important components of my work. Within my artwork I focus on mixed-media techniques which offer me an opportunity to experiment with diverse materials, objects, patterns, textures and layering. I like to explore the interplay between organic shapes and components, creating a dialogue between all the different elements."

Biography

Born in 1956, Colleen Winter, expresses her creativity through drawing, mixed media, collage and sculpture using found objects, paper and textiles. Since childhood Colleen has considered herself a maker and it is the process of making that she enjoys most. She currently resides in Johannesburg.

At age 55 Collen decided to study Visual Arts full time at the University of Johannesburg, majoring in Sculpture and Drawing.
