

Artist Statement

My creativity pays homage to my origins and personal experiences. This is evident in my choice of subject matter and medium. I paint images of sprawling rural landscapes onto traditional grass mats, which all speak about my origins. The ever-present focus of my work is my rural upbringing, along with the sacrifice and support of my mother who raised my siblings and I. I frequently reference my home of Limpopo which is perhaps most recognizably in the landscapes of rolling hills and vast rural scenes I present on grass mats. I use the grass mat as a resting place for my creations. I mirror the intended purpose of the mats as a traditional resting place and usher them into an artistic context where they become replacements of the expected canvas and paper substrates.

Biography

Fumani Walter Maluleke was born in Limpopo in 1991, in the village of Thomo. Fumani has carried with him the spirit of art for as long as he can remember, drawing in school books and on the walls of his family home. Maluleke would later see his artistic talent acknowledged by winning numerous art prizes and sharing his creative skills as an art teacher.
